By the grace of God, we found an accommodating doctor who has been patient with us as we navigate a whole new set of vocabulary words in Spanish. Before continuing with the update, we would like to ask for prayer for **Moises and Rosa Campos**, the missionary couple with whom we have been working. **Recently, Rosa has been diagnosed with an aggressive type of breast cancer.** As such, the doctors have already started her on chemotherapy, and after this, she will likely need additional treatment. We know that the Lord is in control, but we also know that prayer makes a difference. Please keep this precious couple in your fervent prayers as they go through this storm.

In our previous letter, I mentioned a young man from France named **Antonie**, whom I met at the homeless mission in Barcelona. He returned the following month, and although our conversation was brief, I was able to give him an English Bible and our contact info. I do not know if I will see him again, but please continue to keep him in your prayers. Also, at the mission, I had the privilege of preaching in Spanish to three different groups. Little by little, the Lord has opened doors to preach in Spanish, and I am slowly becoming more comfortable doing so. As always, there is plenty of room for improvement, but it is encouraging to be able to minister in the language here.

On the home front, we are humbled and grateful for the amazing opportunities we have had with our neighbors. While we must respect their privacy and cannot share specific details, we can attest to the Lord's faithfulness in opening doors to speak with them. Your prayers have been instrumental in these divine appointments, and we ask for your continued prayers in this regard. We also celebrated both our children's birthdays over the past few months. Catalina is now eight years old, and Justus is now four. Time has flown by, and the kids are growing quickly. Catalina has picked up the language well, and Justus, while it is still a bit of a struggle for him, is gradually understanding more.

At the end of March, I had the opportunity to travel to the Basque Country, a mountainous region in Northern Spain, where I attended an apologetics conference. All the teaching was in Spanish, as was most of the fellowship. The intensive sessions were a great help in expanding my knowledge of evolution terminology in Spanish, and I have already had opportunities to use what I have learned. With the excellent material, I also enjoyed some good fellowship with brethren from around the country.

In closing, we want to express our heartfelt gratitude for your faithful prayers, support, and love. Recently, several churches and individuals have given us additional love offerings. The timing of these gifts is truly remarkable, as each has come in a time of need without us having to ask for anything. The Lord is so good and has used your generosity to increase our faith and provide our needs above and beyond what we could ask or think. Thank you all for your kindness, and we pray that the Lord will bless you richly in your service to Him.
